The meeting was called to order with President Elect Chris Wild reading the anti-trust statement.

- AiLTA Challenge was brought to the Chapter's attention where a contest is being proposed and funded by the William Warren Group in which:
 - The goal is to expedite real estate transactions by drastically lowering the cost and time burden of the land boundary survey
 - The contest is to perform a certified ALTA survey remotely; referenced ALTA a trade association that invests in maintaining the status quo
 - Guidelines include collecting data and a report within 15 hours with less than 1.5 hours of human intervention that meets or exceeds ALTA standards
 - Prizes include 5 concept phase prizes of \$5000 each and 1 prototype prize of \$75000
 - **Should we request FSMS send a cease and desist letter?**
- The chapter discussed running a suggested donation for PAC to receive a gift card.
- Remember to collect pop tops for the Ronald McDonald House
- The BPSM was scheduled to meet and discuss the proposed rule changes
 - These changes should be posted to the DOACS website, where comments can be made for 90 days
 - More changes are still anticipated and prior to implementation must complete the necessary process
 - Commissioner Putnam selected 2 new board members: David Schryver and Chris McLaughlin!
 - Congratulations and thank you for your service Chris!
