**SECRETARY'S REPORT**

*Florida Surveying & Mapping Society, Tampa Bay Chapter  
Thursday, June 21st, 2018 Meeting Minutes*

**Location:** Lee Roy Selmon's at 4302 W. Boy Scout Road, Tampa, FL 33607

**Meeting Start:** 6:31 PM

**Persons in Attendance:** 16 full members and 2 associate members

**Anti-Trust Statement:** The meeting was called to order by President Chris Wild, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance and the reading of the anti-trust statement

**Secretary's Report:** A **motion** was made by Ed Wackerman to accept the May Secretary's Minutes as published in the Field Book. As there was no discussion on the motion, it was seconded by FSMS President-Elect Dianne Collins and passed unanimously.

**Treasurer's Report:** A **motion** was made by Vice President Bob Breedlove to accept the April Treasurer's Reports as published in the Field Book. It was seconded by Bill Newkirk and passed unanimously.

**Committee Reports:**

2018 FSMS Conference Committees:

- Sponsor lists are needed a month early to facilitate printing, unless it is taken care of locally.
- Bob Breedlove requested a handout to give to potential sponsors.
- Shooting for 40 anglers at the Fishing Tournament, have 8 so far. Approximately \$1800 in sponsorships so far.
- More sponsors are needed, particularly for the Golf Tournament.

**SECRETARY'S REPORT (CONTINUED FROM PAGE 2)****Old Business:**

- FSMS President-Elect Dianne Collins reported on a number of items.
  - They obtained some major sponsorships for the FSMS Conference Exhibitor's Reception, including \$11k from Trimble. Trimble also donated an additional \$9k to the Community Foundation of North Florida FSMS Scholarship Fund.
  - Meet and greet with gubernatorial candidate Adam Putnam was held this afternoon. \$43k was donated to his campaign with another \$10k committed.
  - A Tallahassee judge ruled this week that state lawmakers were out of compliance with the Florida Water and Land Conservation Initiative (passed as Amendment 1 in 2014) by using the funds for maintenance of existing conservation lands rather than new property acquisition.
- Reminder that submissions for the new Tampa Bay Chapter logo contest are due prior to the next meeting.
- Vice President Bob Breedlove discussed the search for our new monthly meeting location.
  - The Chapter officers met at La Teresita's last week to try the food and look at the meeting rooms. Food was plentiful and enjoyed by all. It is down the road from our current location. There is a non-refundable room fee of \$118, but meals are in the \$10 range.
  - Bob suggested increasing the price to \$22 dollars to minimize the risk in losing money at the meetings. It was mentioned that meetings used to be \$25 and only went back to \$20 during the recession.
  - Chris McLaughlin made a **motion** to raise the meeting fee to \$25 for full members and guests, and \$20 for associate members. It was seconded by Danny Polk and passed unanimously.
  - Other possibilities were brought up including Cody's Roadhouse in Clearwater and Gaspar's in Temple Terrace.
  - Next month's meeting will be at La Teresita's.

**New Business:**

- TBC Officer Nominations
  - Currently have Vice President Bob Breedlove for President. Treasurer Johnny Beland and Secretary Jared Phillips are nominated to continue in their current positions.
  - Chris nominated Matt Simpson for Secretary and Jared Phillips for Vice President pending Matt's acceptance.
  - Nominees are needed for Vice President and President-Elect. There was talk of getting rid of the President-Elect position and making Vice President the effective President-Elect.
- Donations and Sponsorships
  - The Chapter started this discussion with \$6491 in available funds, and opted to use \$4000 for donations.
  - After an open forum discussion on which of the typical beneficiaries were most in need, a **motion** was made by Joe Shatto to donate \$1,500 to the Tampa Bay Surveying and Mapping Scholarship Fund, \$1,000 to the Community Foundation of North Florida FSMS Scholarship Fund, \$600 to the Tom Kaney Fund, \$400 for the Conference Barbecue, and \$250 each to the Golf and Fishing Tournaments. It was seconded by Jared Phillips and passed unanimously.
  - Treasurer Johnny Beland brought to the Chapter's attention that there were still \$450 in dedicated funds for Gallons for G.I.s, and no one has a contact to send them to. After discussion, a **motion** was made by Jared Phillips to donate the money to Wounded Warriors. It was seconded by Lloyd Braden and passed unanimously.
- An email will be sent out soon to the Chapter regarding the new meeting venue, logo contest, and a reminder for pop tabs to be brought in by next meeting for donation to the Ronald McDonald House Charities.

A **motion** was made by Ed Wackerman at 7:48 to adjourn the meeting. As there was no discussion on the motion, it was seconded by Danny Polk and passed unanimously.
